

Hathaway Brown celebrates 140 years of educating and empowering girls

Ohio's oldest continuously operating college preparatory school for girls started with just five perseverant young women, in a highly unlikely place.

The story—really more the stuff of legend now—began at the all-boys Brooks Military Academy in downtown Cleveland 140 years ago.

At the time, quality education for girls was practically nonexistent. After what likely took some serious convincing, the principal of Brooks agreed to allow Dolly Glasser, Grace Fay Hooker, Clara M. Lyon, Carrie M. Smith, and Carrie A. Tisdale to take classes there in the afternoons, once the boys had left. This seemingly small gesture led to the establishment of a separate all-

girls school the following year.

Today, Hathaway Brown School, nestled on 16 scenic acres in Shaker Heights, continues to educate and empower girls. The school that was built on a foundation of outstanding curricular programs is filled with nostalgia, and an excitable energy brought about by constant innovation.

HB is a proud pioneer in many facets of education for girls – athletics, arts, and sciences to name a few – and ever-evolving programming gives students the best possible preparation for success. Examples include the signature Science Research and Engineering Program, Center for Global Citizenship, and Osborne Writing Center, among
